BTC Phased Safe Return to Play – Outdoor TKD Activity updated 17th July 2020

British Taekwondo Council (BTC) support BTC Registered Instructors delivering outdoor Taekwondo sessions in line with the following guidance from Sport England, sportscotland, sportwales and Sport NI:

BTC Registered Instructors are advised to check with their Local Authority as to their arrangements for fees for delivering training sessions outdoors in public spaces.

BTC Registered Instructors should comply with all the NGB policies and procedures, including Health and Safety (risk assessments, first aid training and equipment reviewed and adapted as required to meet COVID-19 safe practice guidelines), Code of Conduct, Insurance, Social Media and Safeguarding. All participants should be in possession of BTC insurance and anyone under 18yrs should be accompanied by a parent or carer, who should remain apart from the session but in line of sight.

BTC's insurers have clarified and confirmed that the Public Liability Insurance is Civil Liability Insurance. Professional Indemnity Insurance is also included in NGB instructor accreditation.

BTC will update Instructors as and when further changes are approved by the Home Country sports organisations in light of Government guidance.

With effect from 16th July 2020, in light of clarification provided by Sport England in response to concerns raised by Combat Sports, British Judo, British Wrestling, British Taekwondo, British Taekwondo Council and England Boxing, British Taekwondo Council support clubs meeting all the necessary BTC policies and procedures, COVID-19 risk assessment and Government guidelines for social distancing, the following conditions apply to delivering Taekwondo outdoors:
